


## For Horses-In hot conditions, Neutrolene is essential!



Dr Percy Sykes analysed 1379 blood samples taken from racehorses in full work during the 1980's. The results revealed a dramatic drop in pH levels following fast work and again at 2pm in the afternoon. This study revealed an absolute need for an Acid Neutraliser (Neutrolene) in hot conditions.
