IMPORTANT NOTE: Greyhounds with cystitis may have alkaline urine, and a veterinary surgeon should be consulted for correct treatment.

#### **DOSAGE RATES:**

Based on a 30kg greyhound DAILY DOSE: 3mL mixed into food or water when greyhound is in hard work. AFTER RACE DOSE: Add 5mL of Neutramax to the first 1 or 2 meals after racing, handslips or trials or administer directly into mouth by dosing syringe.

Greyhounds suffering from dehydration also require a daily dose of supplementary electrolytes such as Ranvet Salka-lite.
